

Departmental Concerts

Departmental concerts take place throughout the year to showcase the learners from a specific department.

Chamber Concerts

Chamber concerts are held on Tuesdays at 17h30. These concerts offer learners the opportunity to develop stage demeanor and etiquette. A special motivational prize is awarded at each chamber concert, with a grand prize awarded at the end of the year.

Orchestra Concert

This concert is the highlight of our annual orchestral activities as it includes the participation of all the Music Centre orchestras. It usually takes place at the end of the second school term.

Ensemble Concert

The Ensemble Concert grants smaller ensembles the opportunity to perform. Every Music Centre educator is responsible for preparing at least one ensemble for this concert, and interdepartmental ensembles are strongly encouraged.

Concerto Festival

The Concerto Festival, held in August, affords South African school learners and present/past Hugo Lambrechts Music Centre learners up to the age of 20 the opportunity to perform as soloists with our Symphony Orchestra, following auditions held earlier in the year. A separate category for aspiring conductors up to 25 years of age is included.

Prestige Concert

This event takes place at the end of the year, and it culminates in our annual prize-giving ceremony. Approximately 12 of the best performing learners are invited to perform and prizes are awarded to the top achievers of the year. Awards are also given to outstanding learners in our development programme.

End-of-Year Concert

The End-of-Year Concert takes place in December to celebrate the end of the academic year. Orchestras and ensembles perform a variety of Christmas and entertaining music, and learners and parents are encouraged to give donations or bring wrapped presents for distribution to a non-profit organization.
